## Welcome to the Annual General Meeting.

The objective of the PTA is to enrich our children's school experience. We do this by fundraising through organised fun events for our children. The funds raised are then used to pay for resources, equipment and workshops that the school would not otherwise be able to afford within their budget.

The PTA is run by a committee of volunteers, elected each year at the AGM. The AGM is the only formal meeting of the year and deals with the formalities of committee elections, financial reviews and future planning.

This year has been another difficult year for us due to Covid and unfortunately has had an impact on our fundraising. It is not the year we had anticipated or planned. Our biggest fundraiser for 2020 was the Christmas Raffle which raised more than £2200. The Treasurers report and statement of accounts give a breakdown of the figures so please take a look. Sadly this year many events had been put on hold but the PTA team remained committed to finding alternative ways to hold events, have fun and raise money for our school.

We have  $\pm 6,265.50$  in the PTA account and we are discussing with Mrs Claxton the areas she feels the money is most needed. We continue to make a termly donation to each class and a  $\pm 5$  donation for each child for one school trip a year. This year the PTA has funded a whole school educational wildlife experience – Spirit of the wild, funded class workshops such as Greek day and Pirate day, paid for a History timeline and Maps of the world for Geography plus Senco termly contributions. This year we hope to contribute towards a new IT suite to include tables/chairs, Clever touch screens and a desktop PC for the teacher. Longer term initiatives include funding to create a wonderful area for the children at the side of the modular hut plus a KS2 climbing frame.

This year I will be stepping down as Chair. The past 5 years have been truly rewarding in so many ways. It has been a pleasure and privilege to have had this opportunity. I am delighted to announce that Lorna Hudson will be taking over as Chair. I would like to wish her and the team every success in the future.

Alongside my departure is that of our Treasurer Alex Fenn. I would like to thank her for all her amazing work over the past 5 years...its been fun! Laura Woods will be taking over the role of Treasurer, I would like to welcome her to the team.
