PTA - Annual General Meeting - Treasurer's Report

It has been a challenging first year in my role as treasurer of the PTA but for all the right reasons! We were very lucky to be able to bring back many of the events that the PTA have not been able to run throughout the previous pandemic years, so while I was learning the role, others were fairly rusty!

Our first big event was the Christmas Fair and Raffle in which we raised over £3,200! This marked a fantastic start and we are very grateful to those that donated prizes for the raffle and the volunteers that rallied on the day. The sale of children's designed Christmas cards and gifts raised an additional £300.

The spring term brought a couple of movie nights back to the school which were enjoyed by many and raised just under £700. The monthly cake sales also raised a healthy £416 (perhaps not so healthy on the waistline!).

We were very excited to return the summer fair to Albourne School, raising a brilliant £3,000 for the school and more importantly providing a great family afternoon full of entertainment, fun and games.

Other activities that have helped raise funds for the school included second hand uniform sales (£170), sports day refreshments (£90) and lolly sales in summer (£850).

All in all we have raised a whopping £9,200 this year and donated over £10,000 to the school, leaving a bank balance of £7,600 heading into next year.
