Despite our events calendar being cut short our bank account stands at a healthy £8,393.94 at the end of Year, August 2021.

This year's fundraising been a bit different to past years, as unfortunately due to the Covid-19 situation many face to face events couldn't go ahead. So sadly there was no Christmas Fair, Summer Family Fun day, disco's or movie nights.

Our Virtual Christmas Raffle was our highest fundraiser, bringing in just over £2000. Liz Parker, opened a donations Just Giving page with Paypal which has seen generous donations of £2000 this last year too, for which we are very grateful.

In the summer term our weekly ice-lolly sales were a fantastic success, and putting the price up to £1 helped raise £580. Other events able to go ahead include the Christmas cards, Sports Day refreshments, Non-Uniform Day & Second Hand Uniform sale, which together raised another £1,200. A big thank you to all involved with organizing these events.

Again, thank you to everyone who has supported us over the past year. We have raised a fantastic ± 8178.15 , in a tough year for so many of us. This great fundraising effort has allowed us to donate over $\pm 4,500$ to the school!

We have continued to provide the regular termly donations to each class allowing the staff to purchase additional items to support the children's learning, and to subsidise the costs of school outings, at £5 per child.
