Questioner

The Listener will:

 Seek out the answers to their own and others questions.

• *Think* about a question, *discuss* it, *share* and *show* their answer.

Repeat answers to questions when they

are unsure by not opting out.

Perseverer

The Listener will:

- Persevere in their learning and *practise, practise, practise, practise.*
- Show how resilient they are by overcoming disappointment.



Communicator

The Listener will:

- Agree, challenge or elaborate.
- Talk to each other and the adults about their learning.
- Discuss with a *trusted adult* when there are not in the green zone.

Feedback

The Listener will:

- Enjoy critical feedback and use this to improve a piece of work.
- Be specific when giving feedback to someone else.
- Always learn from their mistakes.
